# **Meeting Minutes**

April 12, 2012

## I. CALL TO ORDER (12:00)

A quorum was established and the meeting was called to order. Also attending were Pete Moe & Krista Bouchey, the Funhouse Commons; Jen Vollmer and Susannah Beck, Triple Ripple Running Festival; Jared Lovejoy; Labor Day Weekend Event; Margie Doyle, Cara Cone and Ken Brown, Orcas Issues; Dave Johnson, OISD Facilities Mgr.; and Kate Long.

#### II. PUBLIC COMMENT (12:05)

LABOR DAY WEEKEND EVENT: Jared Lovejoy said that the notion brought
up at last month's meeting of a Labor Day Weekend Event has been received
with enthusiasm by most of the public and officials with whom he has met
including commitment with the Chamber of Commerce and parking
permission from the Port of Orcas for airport parking. He is applied for two
funding grants and was looking for a coalition of organization vs. a private
enterprise.

- TRIPLE RIPPLE: Jen Vollmer introduced her partner, Susannah Beck and asked when ActiveNet would go live and what the procedure would be for them to go forward with registrations. Martha indicated that ActiveNet should be online during the month of May and that Jen and Susannah should prepare their policies and expectations specifically.
- OISD PLAYGROUND DONATION: Dave Johnson indicated that there was a
  playground donated to the school and that, after learning that OISD could not
  accept the donation because of the costs to install it, asked if OIPRD would
  like to accept it. He suggested that the sides be covered for safety. Ian asked

if Dave is legally certified and he said he was, in fact, nationally certified as a playground inspector. He gave the contact number of the potential donor, who he said is willing to donate the playground and platform, built by Chris Doherty, in their entirety. Dave indicated that we would need 12" of playground chips and other specifications to be legal but that he would be willing to donate his time and that we should ask Chris Doherty how much he would charge to reconstruct it. Regarding the value of the gift, Dave mentioned that the slide alone would cost roughly \$10k retail. Martha volunteered to send an email of interest to the donor and Chris.

## III. UNFINISHED BUSINESS (12:30)

· Treasury report - Ian

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Treasury update: We have an expense report. Ian will find out how revenues are distributed to our account. We also have the Wildlife Cycles donation of \$100. Bob asks if we're still needing to use the Port of Orcas loan funds now that we're receiving public fund. Jim responded by saying that, while some projected expenses are coming in later than originally projected, that unless they actually disappear, we will eventually need all funds borrowed per our budget.

- Enduris Ian explained that he is currently filling out information for Enduris as to the 2013 insurance needs – Martha asked him to send us his answers before sending them in.

- Payment of Claims Jim

Jim submitted April's Claims Payment Request for \$18,646.81, which included legal fees, election costs in arrears, equipment and maintenance.

- Deliberations: It was requested that Jim look at last month's submission by Jose from SJC to check against the budget, to make sure we are in alignment. Martha is requesting a budget review and realignment at or around the end of Q2.
- Vote: unanimously aye

The final OIPRD Exec. Director Job Description was approved. It was suggested that Ian add a menu item on the OIPRD website called "Employment" on which the Job Description is listed. It will say that all applications will need to be hard copies sent by mail; that email applications will not be accepted. We also need an end date, which is suggested to be June 1, 2012. Costs: MRSC – free; Linkedin Skagit Valley - \$200.

Jim will add paragraph about hard copy only and address and June 1 deadline. Also, resumes and contact information may be submitted.

We have agreed that Martha will compose the ad within the week and Vicki will list it, at her discretion money-wise, in: The Bellingham Herald, Skagit Valley Herald, Linkedin / Skagit Valley and Seattle Times (Sunday only max); Martha will list it in Park & Rec magazine, Islands Sounder, Orcas Issues, San Juan Journal; and Ian in MRSC.

**Motion:** To give Martha and Vicki permission to go forward with USTA organizing an indoor tennis clinic for June/early July

Funhouse Commons: Pete asked if we need an official agreement and Martha said yes, the Funhouse Commons and OIPRD need to write an official lease agreement, as well as an official programming subcontracting agreement. Jim will create with Pete and Adina. General outline:

- 1. Two-year lease including water and electric, beginning July 1 at \$400/month with 3% annual increases starting Year 2 w/add'l 4-year, one-way OIPRD only option beginning July 1, 2014. Storage room is ours exclusively; Conference room is a shared facility used by first advance booked; FH allows parking, signage, separate entrance, use of bathroom; internet use is not included.
- 2. \$15,000 to subcontract programming:
- 3. Manage and 'roll out' ActiveNet.
- 4. Website/ActiveNet integration
- 5. Inform/teach ED everything.
- 6. Supply OIPRD bookkeeper w/information as requested.
- 7. Share FHC database.
- 8. Design and send brochure Summer / Fall coordinating w/OIPRD's budget constraints.
- 9. Assist w/Buck Park maintenance as needed.
- 10. Manage and/or promote programs for some Spring/Summer/some Fall, including booking, sign ups, equipment setup, parent questions, activity coordination and some staff coordination, etc. for some to all of the following:

Basketball Clinic, Spring Soccer, Wrestling, Sailing, British Soccer, Soccer Camp, Summer Day Camp, Swimming, Quick Start Tennis - as needed, Babysitting classes, Running Club, Ninja day camp, Teen Night, After School programs, Misc. others, as designed and mutually agreed

Buck Park - Bob

- 1. Bob reported that it is his understanding that OISD previously agreed to pay ½ of all Buck Park expenses. Martha suggested that Bob approach Scott Lancaster, Barbara Kline and OISD to remunerate ½ of bills heretofore generated to see if that's still their intention.
- 2. He pointed out that the copper wire for the pump was stolen but was generously replaced/donated by EWUA.
- 3. Dave Smith said the sign is complete and we've determined to delay putting up the sign until such time as OIPRD actually owns Buck Park.
- 4. There is a free software program called CUPPS that is designed to keep all plumbing and water information in one place; a move applauded by the Board.
- 5. Bob's Buck Park maintenance committee of himself, Greg Bronn and Terry Turner are preparing a job description in order to put out to bid to maintain Buck Park; including mowing, skatepark, sanicans and trash.
- Ron Griffin of Griffin Yard Works has agreed to work as an interim service to do some temporary mowing service in case we have our lease with OISD before we have bids ready for review.

The Chamber agreed to be our funding partner for a request I wrote for some LTAC funding for the festival for 2013.

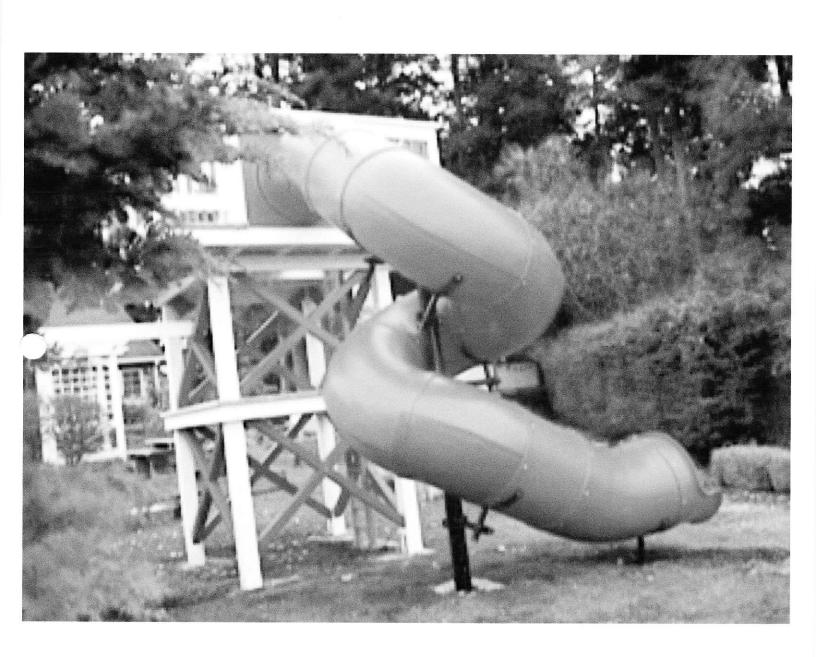
There is a possibility that we may wait till 2013 to produce the first show because there has been such a great response form the community and an event like this would be better served as the production of a community coalition rather than a private group.
