Terri,

I am very sorry to share that, upon review by our legal department, the request you submitted for consideration of a lodging tax award does not qualify. Our attorney indicates that "The proposal is for capital facilities. Only the County, Town of Friday Harbor, State agencies and certain Public Facilities Districts, not including Parks & Rec Districts, are eligible under RCW 67.28 for capital monies".

As such, the committee is not permitted to entertain an award. I wish I could suggest another funding source, and I hope there are some possibilities. The project is obviously very worthwhile.
